1. Overview:

The National Prayer Conference 2026, organized by Intercessors for Uganda, is a strategic gathering designed to fortify the nation's spiritual and moral foundations. Hosted by the **Central region** from **31st August to 5th September 2026**, the conference serves as a platform to further entrench the will and purpose of God in Uganda in this season, and especially in Buganda, the region that played a great role in the founding of Uganda and from which Uganda derives her name. We shall work together with our partners in the Kingdom to achieve this.

Theme: Virtue & Equity as the Nation's Bedrock.

Scripture Anchor: "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne; steadfast love and faithfulness go before you." (**Psalms 89:14**).

2. Rationale:

Uganda's long-term peace and holistic transformation require more than economic advancement; they necessitate a foundation of godly governance, moral integrity, and social equity. This conference addresses both the revisiting of the spiritual foundation and current spiritual stand of the nation as well as practical societal impact, ensuring that national structures are not built on "sinking sand" but on incorruptible virtues.

3. Four Core Objectives

- i. **Foundational Restoration:** To equip the Body of Christ with a biblical framework for righteousness and equity, and to actively uproot systemic corruption and injustice.
- ii. **Unification:** To bring together intercessors from all seven regions of Uganda (Central, Eastern, North Eastern, Northern, North Western, Western, and South Western), and believers from the Body of Christ into a unified team for prayer and action.
- iii. **Spheres Transformation:** To challenge and envision leaders and believers within the Seven spheres of influence: Family, Religion, Education, Government, Media, Arts/Entertainment, and Business/Economy, to better understand their mandate in the Kingdom.
- iv. **Strengthening the Region:** Activities shall be carried out to strengthen the Central Region which is host to the Country's Capital City and to the Central Government of the nation since independence.

4. Methodology and Key Activities

- **Teachings based on the Conference Theme:** Teachings with leanings towards practical application and targeting all spheres. These shall be followed with sessions of prayer into these specific areas to further engage and enlighten participants. (1st- 4th September 2026)
- **National Praise and Worship:** Mobilizing all the 7 Regions for the conference; together with the Israel department in a 24-hour virtual worship session in their local dialects. This will highlight the desire and intention God has in the diversity of ethnic culture while emphasizing the theme of virtue and equity. (Friday 21st August 6 PM to Saturday 22nd August 6 PM)
- **Buganda Prayer School:** A refresher Spiritual Warfare Training to be conducted as a run up activity and precursor to launching the Buganda House of Prayer. (4th July to 15th August)
- **Spheres of Influence Workshops:** The 7 Spheres shall showcase how the Marketplace can influence virtue and equity, in form of workshops and presentations. (3rd September)
- **Launch of the Buganda House of Prayer:** As a pathway to intercede for the Region of Buganda, this shall act as a prayer garrison on behalf of the ethnic peoples of Buganda, launched during the Conference. (4th September)
- **Envisioning the 2026 UJN 50 days of Prayer and fasting season:** A dedicated session to highlight a special annual season when the body of Christ convene together to pray and fast for the Nation. (4th September)

5. Target Audience

The conference targets a broad spectrum of participants, including:

- Intercessors and Prayer Network Leaders.
- Clergy and believers from the wider Body of Christ.
- Professionals, Business Leaders, and Policymakers.
- Cultural and Civic Leaders, Young adults, and Children.

6. Expected Outcomes:

The conference aims to foster a renewed commitment among the Participants to prioritize equity, fairness, and integrity; a better and broader understanding of the Spheres of Influence Kingdom mandate, increase the visibility of ethical conduct within National institutions and communities, to establish a strong altar and an equipped intercessory team in Buganda (Central Region) and a Nationwide network of empowered believers.
